# New Details for the Central Pennsylvania Pride Festival



The 2009 Central PA Pride Parade starts at 10:00 am Saturday, July 25th. Please note that the parade route and formation areas have changed! The parade will march on Second Street turning left on North Street for one block before turning south on Front Street to Walnut Street.

There are 3 different formation areas: 1) on Second Street between Walnut and Locust; (2) on Locust Street between Front and Second; and (3) on Locust Street between Second and Third. We will not know our location until a few days prior and will send out an email immediately thereafter. Please check your email the day prior to Pride. In any case, all three locations are near each other. Plan to be there Saturday morning at 9:30 am.

Our President Jeanine R. is organizing the parade participation, so please let her know if you plan to march. Remember, it's not only open to members, but also guest, friends, spouses, significant others, kids—so come join us! It is about a mile walk, and it's usually hot, so wear footwear and clothing that is comfortable and best projects the transgender person to the public.

The group has purchased 17 wristbands (which admit you to both the parade & festival) for the first people to commit to marching and/or helping 'man' TransCentralPA's booth. Please contact us by sending an email to info@transcentralpa.org.

**Trans-inclusive ENDA** On June 24 Representative Barney Frank introduced H.R. 3017, the Employment Non-Discrimination Act which is substantially the same as the transgender inclusive bill introduced two years ago.

NJ Driver Licenses The New Jersey Motor Vehicle Commission announced late last month that it amended its policy toward gender changes on licenses to facilitate the process for transgender individuals, allowing them to change their gender markers before their sexual-reassignment surgery is complete.
